

Results Information after your First Trimester Screening Clinic (FTSC) appointment

If you have had **Combined Screening** for Patau's, Edwards' and/or Down's syndrome (NT scan and blood test) and your result is calculated as:

- 'lower chance'
You will receive a letter in the post within a week
- 'higher chance'
You will receive a phone call by a midwife from the Fetal Maternal Assessment Unit (FMAU) within 48hours

If you were too late to have Combined Screening and have had the **Quadruple Test** and your result is calculated as:

- 'lower chance'
You will receive a letter in the post within 10 - 14 days
- 'higher chance'
You will receive a phone call by a midwife from the Fetal Maternal Assessment Unit (FMAU) within a week

All other **blood and urine test** results taken at the FTSC will be sent to you altogether in the post, but these may take 3-4 weeks.

Your GP or community midwife will be notified if any problem is found with a result.

Don't forget to make an antenatal clinic appointment with your community midwife for when you are 16 weeks pregnant. At this time the midwife will explain all your First Trimester results.
