How to get to Nuclear Medicine at the Royal Devon & Exeter Hospital (Wonford)

Nuclear Medicine is on Level 1 in Area 'N' – see map on page 2.

There is high demand for parking spaces at our hospital sites so we recommend, where practical and possible, that patients and visitors use other travel options to get here.

Park & Ride services to Wonford

Our on-site car parks are very busy, so we encourage you to use our dedicated **Park & Ride bus services PR3/SPR3**, which run from Sowton (EX2 5GL) and Digby (EX2 7QL), directly to the RD&E Wonford site. These services are run in partnership with Dartline Coaches. They operate Monday to Friday, around every 15 minutes from 6:40am until 7:15pm, then half hourly until 9:40pm

The buses go directly to the RD&E Wonford site, stopping at the Peninsula Medical School (RILD), the Hospital's main entrance, and the Princess Elizabeth Orthopaedic Centre (PEOC).

Please note: The car park at Digby is for permit-holding RD&E staff members only. Visitors, patients and members of staff without permits can still catch the bus from Digby, but they are unable to use the car park.

By bus

Stagecoach buses H Service run to Wonford Hospital from St David's Station, Central Station and High Street in the city centre every 15 minutes Monday to Saturday. Limited Sunday service. They also run to Wonford Hospital from the Digby and Broadfields area.

Stagecoach buses from Exmouth (57), Teignmouth and Dawlish (2), Torbay (7), Newton Abbot (2, 7 and 39) and Plymouth (X38) stop next to the hospital on Barrack Road.

By car

Follow signposts to the hospital from most of the main routes into Exeter. Follow signposts in the hospital grounds to our car parks. Car parking is by pay & display, coins or cards accepted.

The number of spaces is limited, so please leave plenty of time to find a space.

Disabled car parking

There is a short stay parking facility within the blue badge parking area adjacent to the main entrance.

On parking in a blue badge parking bay a ticket must be obtained from the ticket machine located at the entrance to this area. No fee will be required to park. This ticket will enable a blue badge holder to park for 2 hours with no return within 4 hours.

Alternative parking continues to remain free of charge to blue badge holders in any pay and display car park with no time limit with their blue badge displayed on the dashboard of the vehicle.

By train

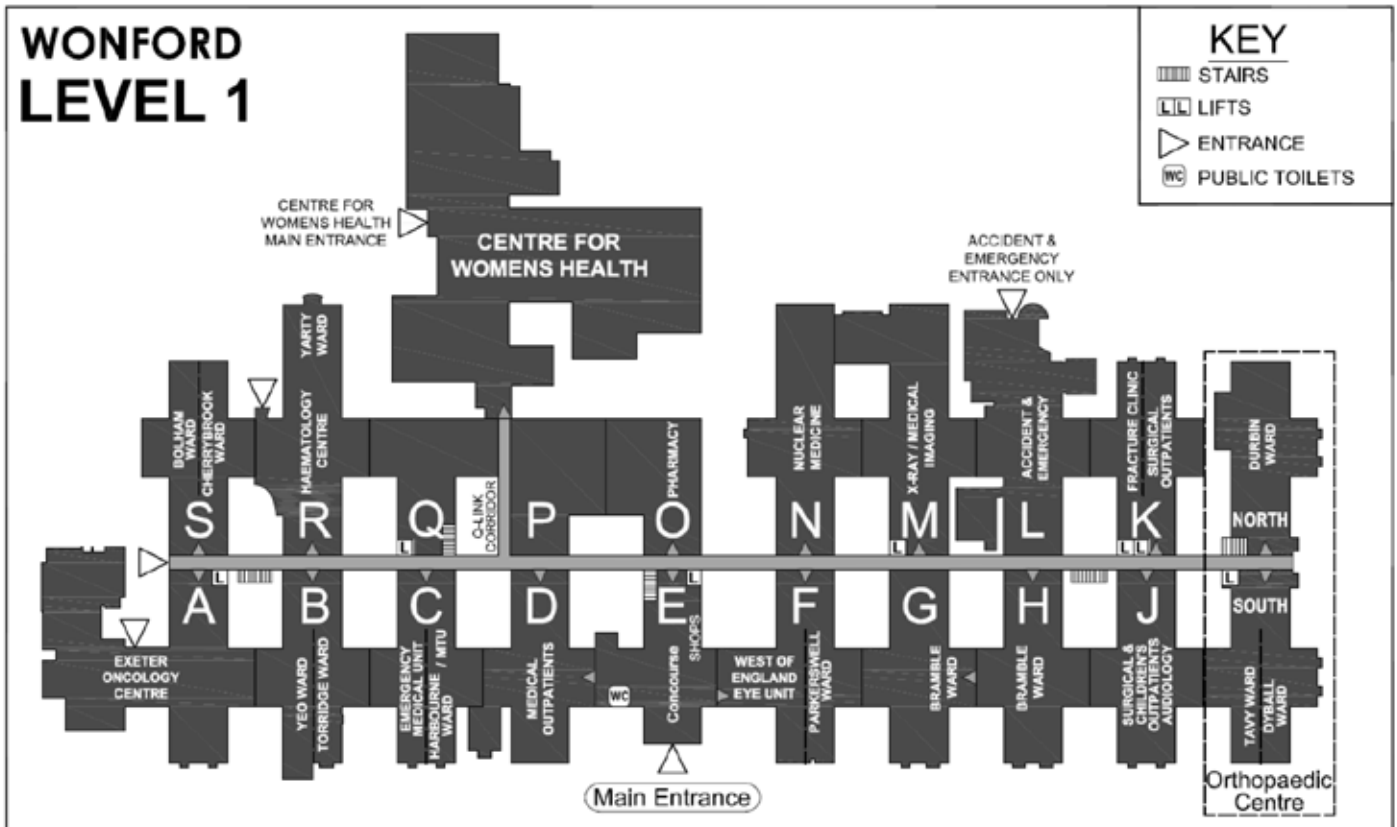
Exeter Central and Exeter St David's stations are about three miles from both Heavitree and Wonford Hospitals. Stagecoach buses H Service run to Wonford Hospital from Exeter St David's rail station and from Exeter Queen Street, outside Central station.
